Results of Vote on Proposed Changes for 2015

The below proposals are the ones which passed at the November meeting. To look at all of the proposed changes, please refer to the October Newsletter.

1. Under FISHING RULES:

Rule 7 states: "...use of drugs..."

Change to: "...use of illegal drugs..."

2. Under FISHING RULES:

Rule 15 states: "The weigh scale will be closed 30 minutes after the last scheduled weigh-in time."

Change to read: "All contestants must be within the no wake buoys on either side of the ramps by the end of the tournament or they will be disqualified."

3. Under MEMBERSHIP:

Currently says: "...an applicant must be a minimum of 55 years of age."

Change to: "...an applicant must be a minimum of 55 years of age, or turn 55 within the calendar year."

4. Under TOURNAMENTS:

Currently says: "in some cases, unequal entry may result in a boater fishing alone."

Add to it: "No Boater will be picked to fish alone more than one time a calendar year. If that Boater has already fished alone, he will be paired with the last selected Non-Boater, who is paired with a Boater, who has not yet fished alone."

5. Under TOURNAMENTS:

Currently says: "Tournaments from September through May shall consist of seven (7) hours of fishing. The summer months of June, July, and August shall be six (6) hours of fishing."

Change to: "All monthly tournaments shall consist of seven (7) hours of fishing."
