NOVEMBER BUSINESS MEETING

The meeting was held on the 16th at Macedonia Church. There were 50 members attendance. Our president, David Larrabee, presided over the meeting.

—A 50/50 raffle was held for \$55 and Sammy Crouch was the winner.

—Fred Kingsmore gave a treasurer's report. We have \$1321 on hand and need approximately \$325 for plaques and jackets. Last year, the awards cost us \$1100, so we are short on money to do the same as last year.

—Things we need to discuss in December. Amount of money to put into awards, giving the church more money, paying of lunch, lowering the Big Bass pay out to \$70, and raising the dues to \$25.

—The club decided to hold the December tournament on the 8th which means the meeting will be on the 7th and the "one on one" will be on the 1st.

—Votes on the proposed changes for 2012 were held with no further discussion of the topics. Twenty six "yes" votes are required for the measure to be passed. Of the fifteen proposals, four passed. Referring the October Newsletter, the measures which passed were numbers 2, 3, 4, and 7.

—Dave McClintic asked our blessing and lunch was served.

—The nomination committee made their recommendations for officers for the coming year. President: David Larrabee; Tournament Director: Jock Prestigiacomo; Secretary: Ed Kelly; Treasurer: Fred Kingsmore. Since there were no nominations from the floor, these were elected by unanimous vote.

—David asked if the club would like to invite a state senator who is on the wildlife committee to speak to the club. The answer was yes. David will try to arrange this for an early 2012 meeting.

—Sam Gray suggested that we send a letter to the editor concerning the marker buoys on the lake. The club agreed that this should be done.

—Results from our October Tournament: Winners were Marvin Brown and Jim Safley with 10 pounds fishing crank baits and worms; Charlie Smith and Roger Isaac with 8.82 pounds fishing worms; Bob Kramer and Earl Greenaway with 7.84 pounds fishing buzz baits, crank baits and worms; Bill Lee and Jon May with 7.07 pounds fishing top water and worms; and, Sam Gray and Richard Garrick with 6.55 pounds fishing worms. Jim Safley caught the Big Fish at 6.81 pounds.

—David and Jock Prestigiacomo then conducted the draw for our November Tournament. Twenty five boats and 45 members are scheduled to blast off at 7:00 with weigh in at 2:00. Three boaters will be fishing alone as there were more boaters than non boaters.

—The meeting was adjourned.

Tournament Director News

The next "one on one" will be held on December 1st from 7:00 —2:00.

Please bring some change for the entry fee; i.e., two 10's or a 10 and two 5's.

Rules for the "one on one":

1. Tournament fee is \$20 per person of which \$5 goes to Big Fish.
2. A seven hour tournament starting at Safe Light or time designated by the TD.
3. If you fish with a partner, fish must be separate at all times.
4. If you come in late, you are disqualified.
5. A quarter pound penalty for a dead fish.
6. A pound penalty for a short fish.
7. Pay out is as follows: 1—9 participants, 100%; 10—15 participants, 60% and 40%; 16 participants and over, 50%, 30%, and 20%.
