The meeting was held on the 20th at Macedonia Church. There were 54 members in attendance. Our president, David Larrabee, presided over the meeting.

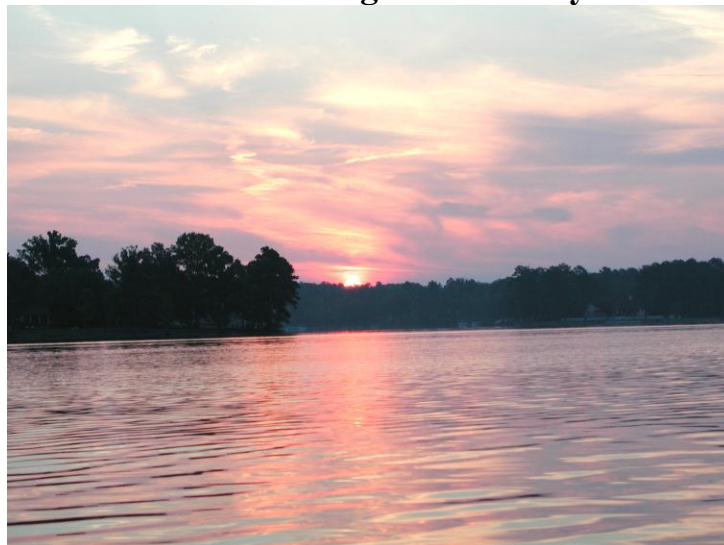


- A 50/50 raffle was held and Clint DeBrand was the winner.

Rules for the “one on one”:

- Tournament fee is \$20 per person of which \$5 goes to Big Fish.
- A seven hour tournament starting at Safe Light or time designated by the TD.
- If you fish with a partner, fish must be separate at all times.
- If you come in late, you are disqualified.
- A quarter pound penalty per dead fish.
- A pound penalty for a short fish.

Payout is as follows: 1—9 participants, 100%; 10—15 participants, 60% and 40%; 16 participants and over, 50%, 30%, and 20%.
