Tournament Director News

The next “one on one” will be held on June 14 from 6:00am —1:00pm.
Remember to check “Breaking News” on the club web site for changes.
Please bring some change for the entry fee; i.e., two 10’s or a 10 and two 5’s.

Rules for the “one on one”:

- Tournament fee is \$20 per person of which \$5 goes to Big Fish.
 - A seven hour tournament starting at Safe Light or time designated by the TD.
 - If you fish with a partner, fish must be separate at all times.
 - If you come in late, you are disqualified.
 - A quarter pound penalty per dead fish.
 - A pound penalty for a short fish.
- Payout is as follows: 1—9 participants, 100%; 10—15 participants, 60% and 40%;
16 participants and over, 50%, 30%, and 20%.

Seniors’ Weigh-In Reminder El Presidente’

A gentle reminder about how our weigh in procedure works. You need to bring your own bag. You need to pick up a number in order to get weighed. Now that the weather will be getting hotter, this is especially important. There should be TWO separate lines. One line is for those waiting for a number and the other line is for those waiting to get weighed. Those of you waiting to get weighed, would you PLEASE form a line perpendicular to Jock’s table. When the line is parallel, the



noise level makes it very hard to hear Joe and Jock. The line parallel to the table should be for those waiting for numbers. If you did not do well in geometry, I will have a visual aid at the next meeting. PLEASE... do not go behind Jock's table and (PLEASE) don't talk to Ed and me while we are trying to record the weights. You may think your small interruption is no big deal, but when it happens three or four times, things get messed up.

PLEASE... wait until the bag ahead of you has been weighed and recorded before telling Joe your boat number and how many fish you have. And if you think you have a short fish, YOU need to measure it before it goes in the sink. Once you dump it in the sink, there are no "do overs". Thanks.
